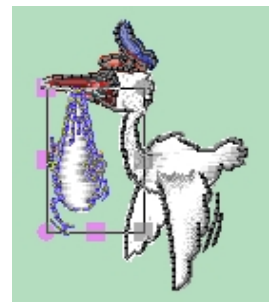
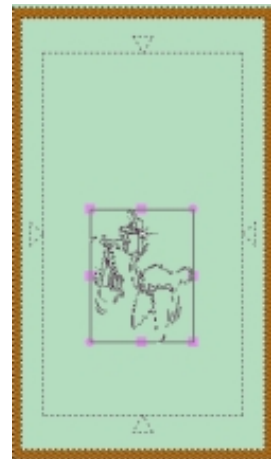






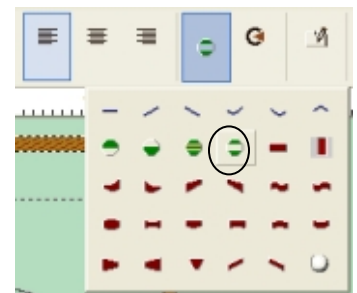
Futura CE-150 Embroidery Demo

1. Open your Singer Futura Software by clicking on the desktop icon.
2. After reading the Tip of the Day, click Close.
3. The Welcome to Futura box will open.
4. Click on 'Open a design from Design Library' and the Design Library will open.
5. Make sure 'for Large Hoop' is selected on the left, and then scroll down to find 'bird_1002.' It is a stork carrying a baby.
6. Click the stork, then click OK. The stork will appear as an outline on the screen with a selection box around it.
7. To resize the stork, click and drag the left corner square of the selection box making the stork about 1 inch bigger on screen as shown.
8. Right click, and click Apply and the stork will be resized on screen.
9. Click View and choose Realistic Mode to see the stork as thread – it looks great!
10. Click Design and then click Center Design to center the stork in the hoop.
11. Change the color of the baby bundle outline by clicking on the last color clock in the Color Block List along the bottom of the screen.
12. Click the green color block at the top of the screen and then click on the color rainbow to select the new color. Then click OK.



Add lettering

13. Click Lettering  and the Lettering toolbar will open.
14. In the box on the far left, type 'Special' then press the Enter key on your keyboard ONCE to get to the second line, then type 'Delivery.'
15. Choose Script 2 for the Font, and set the Height to 150. Leave the Spacing at 10. Justification will not matter because we will be using a circle Font Frame.
16. For the Font Frame,  choose the second row, fourth option which has a green section on the top and bottom.





Notice you can see the font on the screen in the new frame.




17. Click on the center square in the middle of the circle and move the lettering to be centered around the stork.
18. If you want to change the color, click the color block and choose from the color rainbow. Then click OK.



19. When you are happy, right click and choose Stitch it, or click Stitch It  on the lettering toolbar.

You are ready to stitch out your design.

20. Click Transmit to machine .

21. Choose either Send design or Send block – and begin embroidering your design. Please consult pages 34 – 35 of your Futura Embroidery Software User’s Manual – found under Help, Open the Manual... for more information on sending the design.
